FERAL WILD BOAR CONTROL PROGRAM

Saskatchewan producers and landowners can access support for controlling feral wild boar. On behalf of the provincial and federal governments, through Growing Forward 2, Saskatchewan Crop Insurance Corporation (SCIC) has assumed administration of the Feral Wild Boar Control Program and will operate it as part of its Wildlife Damage Compensation Program.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

1. When a wild boar sighting occurs, the individual should contact their local Crop Insurance office as soon as possible.
2. SCIC will review the information and determine the next step for responding to the wild boar sighting.
3. There are teams established in the province, made up of experienced hunters and trappers, who have a response protocol to act on the complaint.
4. When it has been determined control measures are needed a hunt is conducted. These hunts have been successful in removing feral wild boar throughout the province.
