Harvey is currently the Reeve for the RM of Sliding Hills No. 273 and was elected as Director of Division 4 at the 2006 SARM Annual Convention.

He completed his grade 12 education at Canora Composite High School and went on to complete three years of post-secondary education at the University of Regina. In 1985, Harvey was elected to the Canora School Board and served 12 years, two years as Chair.
