Training Recertification

- Required every five years.
 1. Write a recertification exam.
 2. Recertify by accumulating Continuing Education Credits (six license categories).

- Accumulate Continuing Education credits.

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Training Recertification with CEC's

- Accumulate 15 CEC's in the five year period.
(maximum 10 CEC's in one year)
- Minimum requirements in specific concept areas.

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Minimum of 2 credits in these Concept areas:

- Regulations
- Human Health & Safety
- Pest Management
- Application Technology

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Minimum of 1 credit in this Concept area:

- Environment

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Other Concept areas(no minimum requirement):

- General Information
- Labels & Material Data Sheets
- Emergency Response
- Professionalism

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Process for Recertification with CEC's

1. Accumulate 15 CEC's in five years and meet minimum requirements in the Concept areas.
2. Register with SaskPolytechnic.
3. Receive "Statement of Achievement" from SaskPolytechnic.

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Process for Recertification with CEC's (cont.)

4. Provide a copy of your “Statement of Achievement” to the Saskatchewan Ministry of Agriculture with your Pesticide Applicator license renewal application.

5. Receive your Pesticide Applicator license.

- Call the Pesticide Education Program
- We will send you a PLAR registration form
- Complete and return form to the Program
- You will be contacted to pay registration fee
- We issue your “Statement of Achievement”
