1) GENERAL				
In consideration of the participating municipalities— contribution to operating costs and capital replacement as provided herein, covenants and agrees to continue to provide the service of the Rescue Unit upon request of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police within the boundaries of the participating municipalities and further agrees to provide the necessary labour, equipment and training to maintain an efficient and safe service for the term of this agreement.

The Town of shall be responsible for administering this agreement and accounting to the member municipalities shall be responsible for preparing and circulating the minutes of the annual meeting and budget, issuing bills to the member municipalities for their operating and capital contributions, and reporting to the member municipalities each September with year-to-date revenues and expenditures, and within 45 days of December 31 in each year with a year-end statement of revenues and expenditures.
7) <u>DONATIONS</u>
will solicit grants or donations from service clubs and First Nations councils in the area served by the Rescue Unit, as well as from appropriate outside agencies and government departments. Unless otherwise specified by the donor, any funds generated by such solicitation shall be allocated to operating revenues.
8) <u>OPERATING SURPLUS</u>
The participating municipalities agree that any operating surplus shall be transferred to the Capital Reserve Account.
9) <u>REPRESENTATIVES</u>
and the participating municipalities shall each appoint one person for the purpose or representing them at the annual budget meeting and reporting to their respective municipalities as required. The individual representative may be an elected member of council, or such other individual as the municipality may deem appropriate for such appointment.
10) WINDING UP
In the event that this agreement is terminated and the Rescue Unit service is discontinued, it is agreed that the Rescue Unit vehicle, extrication equipment and other assets used by the Rescue Unit shall be sold. The proceeds of such sale and the balance of the Capital Reserve Account shall then be distributed by paying the proceds of the sale of equipment owned by at the date hereof as shown on Appendix AB@ attached, to,

and distributing the balance, after paying any current expenses and reimbursing service clubs for any donations made to the Capital Reserve Account, to all of the participating municipalities and \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ on a per-capita basis.
