RURAL MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION FORM

The SARM Rural Municipal Administration Scholarship Program is for students enrolled in the Local Government Authority Program at the University of Regina. Three scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded annually, paid at the end of the completed semester. Applications must be received by SARM no later than **October 15th** and must be supported by confirmation of enrolment during the current year.

Selection is based on academic achievement, demonstrated interest in Administration as a career in rural Saskatchewan, contributions to and knowledge of rural Saskatchewan, and the following criteria.

CRITERIA

- Must be registered in or completed at least three to six credit hours of the Local Government Authority program at the University of Regina in the current year.
Must NOT be participating in a tuition reimbursement program.
- Must include ONE copy of high school transcript(s) and/or post-secondary transcript(s).
Must include ONE reference letter from teacher, employer, or community leader.
- Must demonstrate interest in Administration as a career in rural Saskatchewan, contributions to and knowledge of rural Saskatchewan (through an essay).
