



SASKATCHEWAN BROADBAND ACTION COMMITTEE

Context and Background:

The Saskatchewan Broadband Action Committee (SBAC) is a cross-sector and community-based group of provincial, local and Indigenous organizations, networks and service providers, formed through a shared and collective concern over the issues and lost opportunities for all citizens related to broadband connectivity across the province. The key focus of the Committee is to:

- Assist with addressing long-standing issues affecting broadband connectivity; and,
- Advise and direct actions leading to a shared strategy, investment, and vision.

Our Collective Vision:

Committee members have committed to promote the following shared vision statements:

By 2024, Saskatchewan's broadband infrastructure would have achieved parity for 100% of Saskatchewan residents (50 Mbps download and 10 Mbps upload), regardless of location and community.

By 2027, 100% of Saskatchewan citizens exceed the CRTC standard by accessing 100 Mbps download and 50 Mbps upload, regardless of location and community.
