Awarded to Reeves, Councillors, or Administrators (active or retired) for their lifetime contribution to rural Saskatchewan.

2024 Nomination Period NOV 1, 2023 - JAN 31, 2024

Candidates must be nominated by an RM, with council's approval, and administrator's sign-off.

Applications are valid for two-years (the first year of the nomination and the next year). Nominees must be living at the time of nomination, should a nominee that is eligible for the second year of consideration pass before the next nomination period, the nomination is no longer valid.
