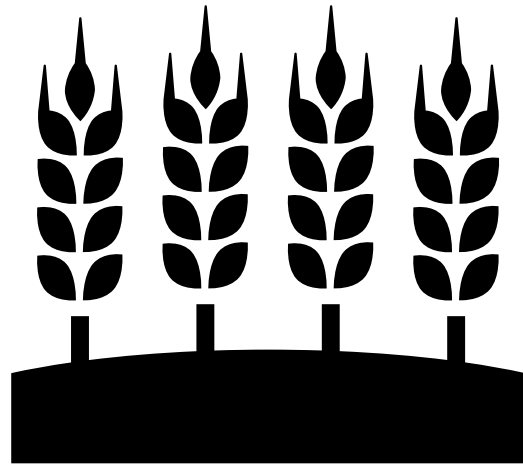


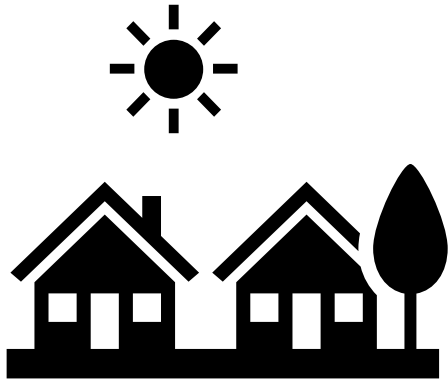
Saskatchewan in 1912....

- *The Rural Municipalities Act*
- RM size – 324 square miles
- Each division – 54 square miles
- Approximately 1 person per square mile



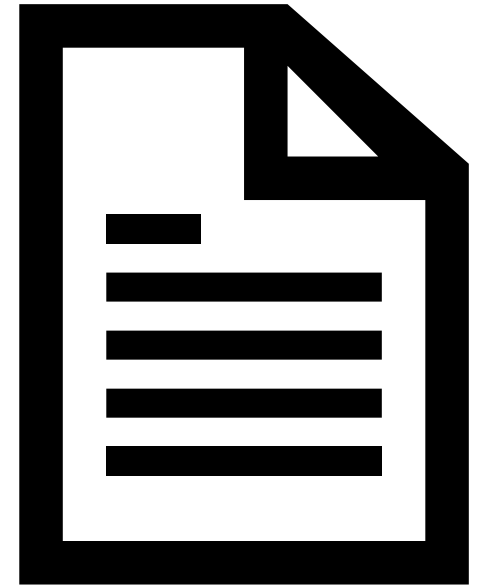




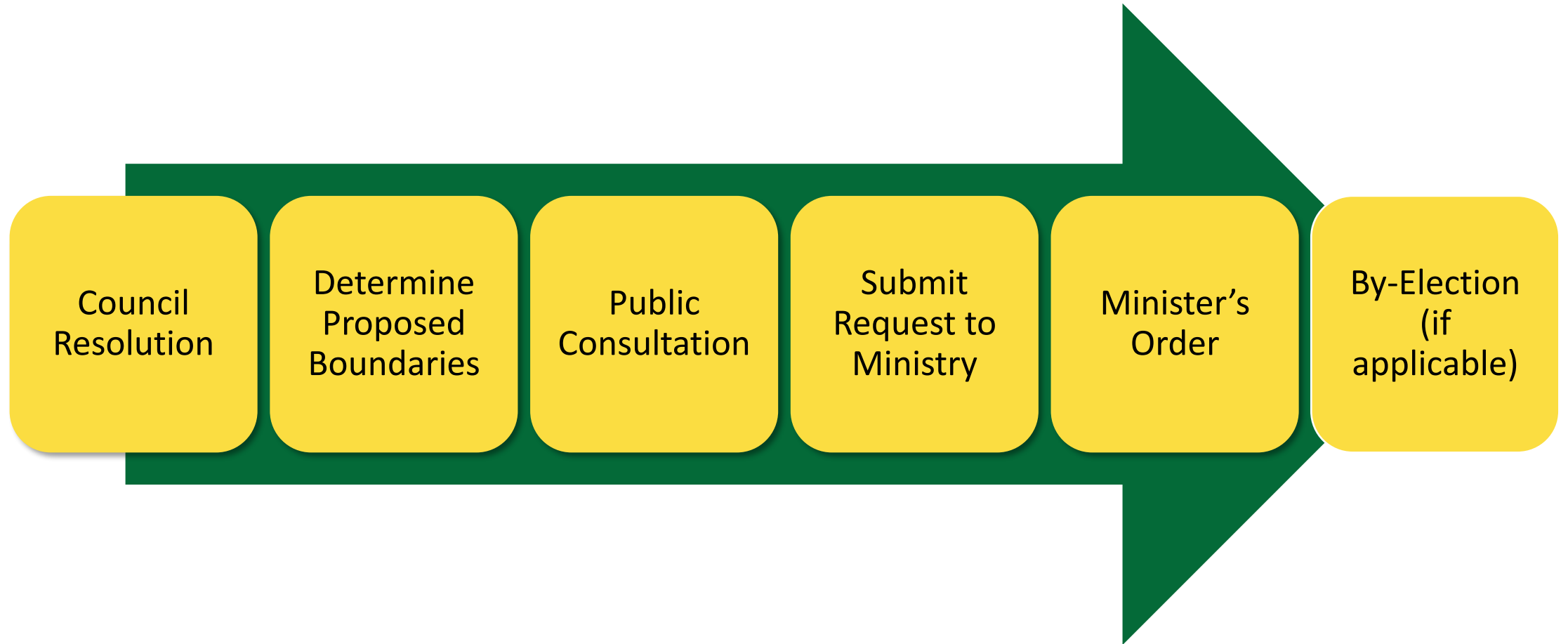


Division Boundary Review Policy

- Required to be in place by January 1, 2023
- Act outlines items required to be in policy
- Policy to review, not necessarily change
- No policy = Elections at large

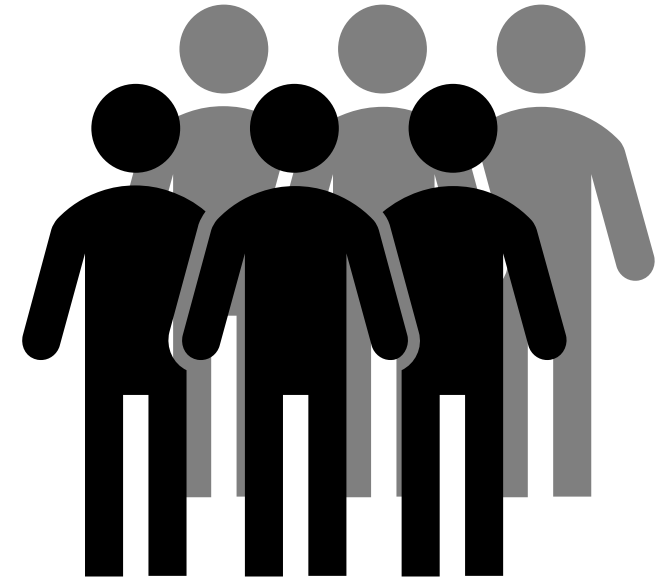


Process to Change Division Boundaries



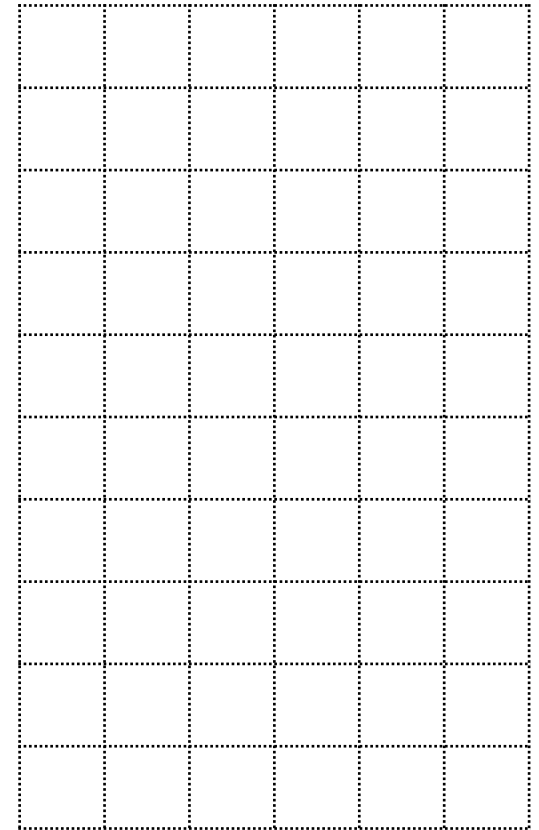
Election at Large

- All councillors elected every 4 years with Reeve
- Apply to remove all division boundaries
- Determine number of councillors
- Voter qualifications remain the same



Election by Division

- Vote for reeve **and** vote for one division only
- Division determined by first that applies:
 - Where voter resides
 - Where voter owns assessed property
 - Where voter holds permit as occupant of trailer or mobile home
